

AOT Packing List

****Official Dress is not needed!**

- Arrive on Thursday in tasteful casual; this can include
 - Jeans or shorts
 - Nothing ripped or holey that exposes undergarments
 - Nothing excessively short; should be school-appropriate
 - Nothing excessively tight
 - T-shirts or polos
 - No tank tops or spaghetti straps
 - Nothing see-through
 - Nothing with political or school-inappropriate messages, images, or language
 - Sneakers, boots, flip-flops, etc.
- 2 sets of business casual, one for Friday and one for Saturday; this includes
 - Slacks
 - Polo or button-down shirt
 - Belt
 - Socks
 - casual dress, shoes, boots, or clean sneakers
- 2 sets of tasteful casual for outdoor activities and recreation (see Thursday attire for description)
- Swimsuit (optional)
 - Boys must wear trunks that are not excessively short or tight-fitting
 - Girls may wear one-piece or two-piece. Either should provide appropriate coverage and should not be bikini-style.
- Toiletries
 - Washrags and towels for three days
 - Shower shoes
 - Soap
 - Shampoo
 - Toothbrush and toothpaste
 - Comb, brush, and hair-care products
 - Shaving cream and razor
 - Deodorant
 - Feminine products
 - Medications, if needed
- Sleeping
 - Pillow
 - Sleeping bag or sheets and blankets for a twin-sized mattress
