Convention Details

- Dates:** June 1-4, 2026
- Location:** Randolph Riverfront Center, 707 2nd Street, Alexandria, LA 71301
- Details:** Per State Bulletin 741, each advisor and a minimum of two members per chapter are required to attend convention. In addition to delegate work, activities will include state award presentations, motivational speeches by state and national officers, an engaging career expo, informational workshops, Career Development Events, Day of Service activities, and more!
- Dress Code:** All FFA members should be in full Official Dress at all times in the convention center and when participating in events in the hotels. Tasteful casual is acceptable at the concert, Day of Service, dance, and fireworks. Adult attendees should wear business professional. This means coat, tie, and slacks for men and a dress or a blouse/dress shirt with dress pants/skirts for women.

Convention Fees

- Early Registration:** \$35 per person; due by May 8; payment must be postmarked by this date; registration can be accessed at la-ffa.org/what-we-do/state-convention-and-expo/registration.html.
- Late Registration:** \$40 per person
- One-Day Pass:** \$5 per day; for non-member, non-advisor guests only

Housing, Parking, and Travel

There is free parking all around the Riverfront Center. You can park in the lot on Jackson Street in front of the Southern Heritage Bank, the lot on 2nd Street behind the Holiday Inn, or the parking garage on 4th Street across from St. Francis Xavier Cathedral. School buses can park in the lot behind the Holiday Inn and Riverfront Center off of 2nd Street.

Chapters must provide their own transportation to Day of Service events.
